
How To Make Flour Paint: Natural, Non-Toxic, Durable & Cheap

Normal outdoor wood paint is expensive, an ecological nightmare (eco paints cost even more money!), they are toxic, harmful to nature/humans, take ages to dry and you have to use even more nasty chemicals to clean your brushes etc when you are done...

What if I told you there is a natural, healthy/eco alternative that's easy to clean, dries in an hour and that costs the equivalent of a few dollars a tin? It's called flour paint, or Swedish Paint! Just mix the natural ingredients in a pan on the stove and in 30/40 minutes you'll have an awesome natural rustic outdoor wood paint that will last for between 5-10 years depending on your location/weather etc. You are not restricted to red either, there are a whole load of natural earth pigments you can use to color your paint.
